The course is designed such that it highlights the important work of an adult as an assistant to the child's development. It opens the way for adults to assist children both at home and in school. It helps interested adults work with children in a Montessori environment. Upon completion of the course requirements, participants are awarded a certificate from AMI.

Observation

Observation is a requirement for the certification. Students will need to observe a child, a plant, a thing or a painting and videos. They will be required to record and submit a written report of their observations.

Language

All lectures will be in English. Course work will need to be presented in English.

AMI REQUIREMENTS FOR CERTIFICATION

Admission to the Programme does not guarantee certification. Each student must meet the following, basic requirements in all areas of the course in order to receive the AMI Assistants Certificate 6-12 at the end of the Programme:

Certification:

1. A minimum of 90% attendance at all lectures and pre-recorded sessions.
2. Obligatory reading as directed by the course.
3. The completion of the observation and observation notes as directed by the course trainer.
4. Submission and completion of three papers (500 words each) or the equivalent assignment on topics set by the trainer to be submitted by the date stipulated by the course.
